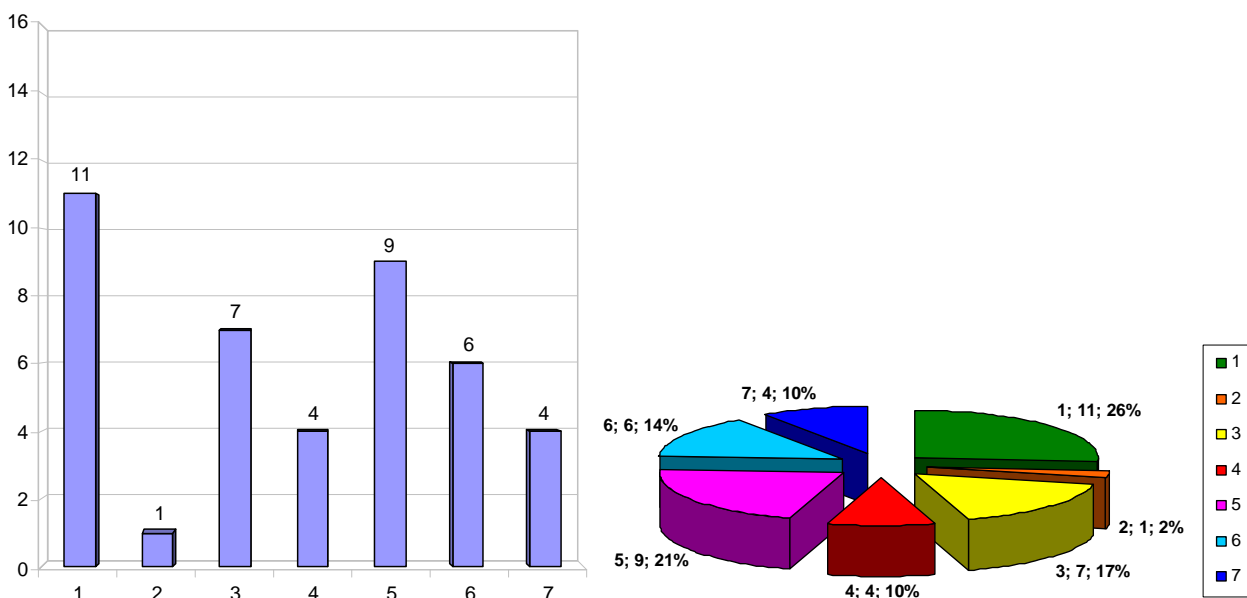
The Info day within the Tempus project WBC-VMnet, was held on 23 Jun, 2010. in Hotel "OLIMPIC" in Ulcinj, with VII Conference of Maintenance "KOD 2010".

Info day in Ulcinj consisted of the following:

- Welcome speech by Ph.D. Miodrag Bulatović, Full professor at University of Montenegro, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering in Podgorica, President of Organizing Committee of Conference of Maintenance "KOD-2010";
- The presentation of the WBC-VMnet Project by Ph.D. Mileta Janjić, Assistant professor at University of Montenegro, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering in Podgorica, Contact person of Partner. The presentation of the project is carried out and what has been done on the project till now;
- Paper: "T&SNA - Trening and Service Needs Analysis in Small and Medium Enterprases in Montenegro" by authors: Mileta Janjić, Vesna Mandić and Drago Miljanić i presented by Ph.D. Mileta Janjić, Assistant professor at University of Montenegro, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering in Podgorica, Contact person of Partner. - Representative of Partner from industry from Montenegro M.Sc. Drago Miljanić oresented his impressions about participation in WBC-VMnet Project;
- Discussion with the participants of the Info day;

Participants of the Info day from enterprises, faculties and research centers, have expressed great interest for the current project activities, the results of T&SNA, the activities of Cooperative Trening Centres, the proposed model of cooperation between University and enterprises, IFP and PPP programs.

According to the questionnaires' results, filled out by the participants, the general evaluation mark was **4,43 out of 5**. When asked which of these models of cooperation were most appropriate and useful for the implementation and launching of University modernization and industry transformation, as well as for launching innovation, the participants answered in percents, as follows:



1. The establishment of scientific and technology parks in regional university centers that can be generators for the new start-up and spin-off companies;
2. The establishment of regional industrial clusters at the level of Western Balkans, depending on the research areas and operations;
3. Forming a consortium of universities and companies to jointly participate in FP7, TEMPUS, EUREKA and other projects financed by the European Union;
4. The establishment of regional collaborative training and/or Lifelong education centers;
5. The establishment of open innovation networks;
6. Student mobility within the student practices;
7. IF programme for graduates and employees.
